PROGRAM FOR HOUSTONIANS AFFECTED BY FLOODING AND SEVERE WEATHER
PHONE LINES OPEN NOON UNTIL 9:00 P.M. ON JUNE 3**

(HOUSTON – MAY 28, 2015) Attorneys from the Houston Bar Association will answer questions and provide legal advice over the phone for those in the Houston area affected by the recent floods and severe weather during an extended LegalLine program from **noon until 9:00 p.m. on Wednesday, June 3**. The public is invited to call **713-759-1133** to speak to an attorney knowledgeable in insurance matters, property, landlord/tenant law, contracts, disaster assistance and other consumer issues.

“We recognize that many people in Houston will have a need for legal advice on how to deal with the damage they experienced,” said Laura Gibson, president of the 11,200-member Houston Bar Association. “To meet this need, members of the Houston Bar Association are hosting an extended LegalLine program to give advice to those who have been adversely affected by the flooding conditions.”

LegalLine, a public service of the Houston Bar Association, is normally held on the first and third Wednesday of each month from 5-9 p.m., giving area residents the opportunity to call in and speak to volunteer attorneys for answers to legal questions, brief legal advice and other resources.
